HTML Attributes

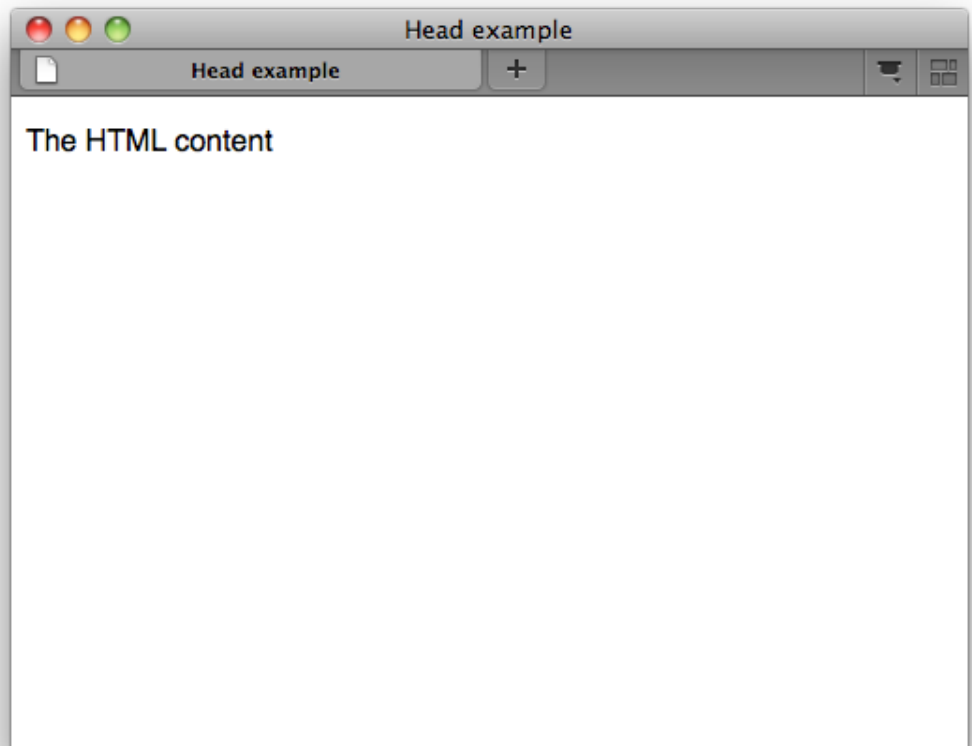
See global attributes.
